**GRANTING EXTENSION AND REVISING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's March 25, 2019, request to extend the time to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to the City of Lucas. Commission Staff states that the City of Lucas does not object to the extension.

The administrative law judge grants Commission Staff's request for extension and revises the procedural schedule as follows:

Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to the City of Lucas for review and consent	April 15, 2019
Deadline for the City of Lucas to file signed consent forms with the Commission	April 29, 2019
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	May 6, 2019
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact, including findings that address the factors in Texas Water Code § 13.246(c), and corresponding conclusions of law	May 13, 2019
