

## NOTICE OF PREHEARING CONFERENCE Anderson Water Company, INC. SOAH Docket No. 473-20-1117.WS PUC Docket No. 48697

#### **Application**

Anderson Water Company, INC has applied to the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUC or Commission) to change its water rates/tariffs for its service areas located in Grimes County. Although the preliminary rates have already been in effect since April 26, 2019 they have not been finalized with the commission. We are making you aware of a formal prehearing that is taking place to fully establish these rates.

#### **Prehearing Conference**

The telephonic prehearing conference scheduled for January 22, 2020 was canceled. A prehearing conference will now be convened at the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH):

Tuesday, March 3, 2020 William P. Clements Building 300 W. 15th Street 4th Floor Austin, TX 78701

At the prehearing conference, the parties should be prepared to discuss any procedural matter, any pending motions including motions to intervene, the procedural schedule including hearing dates, and any other relevant matters. The evidentiary phase of the proceeding will be similar to a civil trial in the state district court. The prehearing conference will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001 of the Texas Government Code; Chapter 13 of the Texas Water Code; the PUC's Substantive Rules, including Title 16 of the Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 24; and the PUC's Procedural Rules, including 16 TAC Chapter 22. Any person wishing to intervene in this case (i.e., participate in this case as a party) shall move to intervene either: (1) in a written request to intervene filed at the PUC by no later than March 3, 2020; or (2) at the March 3, 2020 prehearing conference. Any motion shall refer to SOAH Docket No. 473-20-1117.WS ad PUC Docket No. 47976, include the person's contact information, and otherwise comply with the Commission's procedural rules. Previous submission of a protest does not meet the requirement that a person who wants to participate as a party must move to intervene as described above.
