JOINT MOTION FOR INTERIM RATES

On October 1, 2018, Anderson Water Company (Anderson) filed an application for a water rate change under Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11675 in Grimes County. On April 16, 2020, the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 6 referring this case to mediation, and a mediation was scheduled for July 17, 2020.

Through mediation, the Parties have reached an agreed resolution of this docket that is reasonable and in the public interest. The Parties therefore respectfully request the approval of the agreed upon rates as interim rates for Anderson Water to replace the interim rates approved in SOAH Order No. 9 filed on October 5, 2020.
