SOAH ORDER NO. 12 ADMITTING EVIDENCE; REMANDING TO THE COMMISSION; AND DISMISING CASE FROM SOAH

On July 15, 2021, Anderson Water Company, Inc. and Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) filed a Motion to Admit Evidence and Remand to the Commission. The parties have entered into a unanimous Stipulation (Stipulation) resolving all issues in this docket, which was also filed on July 15, 2021. The Motion requests that evidence be admitted into the record to support the approval of the parties' Proposed Agreement (Attachment A to the Stipulation) and that the settled case be remanded to the Commission for final disposition and consideration of the Stipulation and Proposed Order. The parties also request that the Administrative Law Judge dismiss this proceeding from the docket of the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH).

The evidence offered by the parties for admission into the record, as indicated below, is **GRANTED**. The evidence is **ADMITTED**, and the parties **SHALL** submit an electronic version of the Proposed Agreement to the Commission via <u>cadmorders@puc.texas.gov</u>.

- 6. Joint status report and request to cancel prehearing conference, filed on January 10, 2020 (Interchange Item No. 41);
- 7. Anderson's proof of notice of prehearing conference, filed on February 24, 2020 (Interchange Item No. 45);
- 8. Direct testimony of Jessica Sechelski, filed on April 6, 2020 (Interchange Item No. 47);
- 9. Stipulation and Settlement Agreement and all exhibits, filed on July 15, 2021 (Interchange Item No. 66); and
