**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND ESTABLISHING
OPPORTUNITY TO CURE; AND SUSPENDING EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation that the administrative law judge (ALJ) find the application deficient and provide Anderson Water Company, Inc. an opportunity to cure the deficiencies described in the recommendation.

The ALJ finds the application incomplete and deficient. The Commission does not consider applications filed until it makes a determination of administrative completeness. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before December 10, 2018, Anderson Water Company, Inc. must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described by Commission Staff. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. Anderson Water Company, Inc. should not issue notice until the application is administratively complete.

On or before January 10, 2019, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.

Under Texas Water Code § 13.1871(e) and Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(b), the effective date of the proposed rate change is suspended until a properly completed application is accepted.
