COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On September 18, 2018, Anderson Water Company, Inc. (Anderson) filed an application for a rate change pursuant to Tex. Water Code (TWC) § 13.1871.

On January 4, 2022, the Office of Policy and Docket Management (OPDM) filed a memo establishing a deadline of January 18, 2022 for Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) and Anderson to file a clarification on specific issues. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Anderson and Staff (collectively, the Parties) are continuing to work on preparing a responsive filing to the OPDM memo; however, in order to prepare a fully responsive filing the Parties require additional time. Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order extending the deadline for Staff to file a response to OPDM's memo to February 18, 2022.
