**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT; AND ESTABLISHING
AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the application filed by Denton Sorrells, LLC and Punkadilly, LTD. (applicants) for expedited release of 386 acres of land within the boundaries of Aqua Texas, Inc.'s water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 13201 in Denton County. On October 19, 2018, Commission Staff recommended that the administrative law judge (ALJ) find the application deficient and provide the applicants an opportunity to cure the deficiencies described in the recommendation.


The ALJ finds the application incomplete and deficient. Under Title 16 of the Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before November 19, 2018, the applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described by Commission Staff. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicants must not issue notice until the application is administratively complete.

On or before December 19, 2018, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
