**ORDER NO. 3  
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT; AND ESTABLISHING  
AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's November 2, 2018 recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the City of Edinburg's application. Commission Staff recommends that the administrative law judge (ALJ) find the application deficient and provide the City of Edinburg an opportunity to cure the deficiencies described in the recommendation.

The ALJ finds the application incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.


On or before December 13, 2018, the City of Edinburg must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described by Commission Staff in its recommendation. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The City of Edinburg must not issue notice until the application is administratively complete.

On or before January 11, 2019, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
