



Re: Docket NO 48725, Application for a Price Index Rate Adjustment

To whom it may concern:

UA Holdings, 1994-5 LP, dba SC Utilities request to withdraw the Application for a Price Index Rate Adjustment, Docket NO. 48725, which includes Sewer CCN No. 20586 and water CCN NO. 11749. We found a mistake before mailing the notice to the customers.

The original Application requested an index rate adjustment for only Sunrise Ranch Subdivision rates thinking that these rates were the only rates in the Tariff. The Tariff for CCN 20586 has three separate rate structures for three different systems. I have attached a copy of the water & sewer tariffs with this request of withdrawal.

UA Holdings, 1994-5 LP would like to refile an Application for a Price Index Rate Adjustment using the correct rate structures for each system according to the Tariff. The new filing will contain request for sewer rate changes for Sunrise Ranch, Spring Cypress Center, and Meadow Vista Business Park. 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PURCHASED WATER AND/OR DISTRICT FEE PASS THROUGH CLAUSE

Changes in fees imposed by any non-affiliated third party water supplier or underground water district having jurisdiction over the Utility shall be passed through as an adjustment to the water gallonage charge according to the following formula:

AG = G + B/(1-L), where

AG = adjusted gallonage charge, rounded to the nearest one cent:

G = approved gallonage charge (per 1,000 gallons);

B = change in purchased water/district gallonage charge (per 1,000 gallons);

L = system average line loss for preceding 12 months not to exceed 0.15

TEMPORARY WATER RATE:

Unless otherwise superseded by TCEQ order or rule, if the Utility is ordered by a court or governmental body of competent jurisdiction to reduce its pumpage, production or water sales, the Utility shall be authorized to increase its approved gallonage charge according to the formula:

$$TGC = cgc + (\underline{prr})(\underline{cgc})(\underline{r})$$

Where:

TGC = temporary gallonage charge

cgc = current gallonage charge

r = water use reduction expressed as a decimal fraction (the pumping restriction)

prr = percentage of revenues to be recovered expressed as a decimal fraction, for this tariff prr shall equal 0.5.

To implement the Temporary Water Rate, the utility must comply with all notice and other requirements of 30 T.A.C. 291.21(l).

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
