ORDER NO. 2
REQUIRING ADDITIONAL NOTICE AND
ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the application, proposed notice, and proposed procedural schedule filed by Entergy Texas, Inc. on October 9, 2018.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application sufficient for further review under PURA¹ § 39.452(k)-(1). Entergy provided notice to all parties that participated in Docket No. 47416;² however, notice of the application must also be provided to all parties that participated in Docket No. 47472.³

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule for this proceeding:

Event	Date
Deadline for Entergy to provide proof of notice	November 5, 2018
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice was provided
Deadline for intervenors to request a hearing	10 days after the intervention date
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation or request a hearing	20 days after the intervention date
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file an agreed proposed order including findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs	7 days after Commission Staff's deadline to request a hearing
