ORDER NO. 3
FINDING NOTICE DEFICIENT; AND
REVISING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the application of the City of Marshall to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity and the deficiencies of the notice.


On December 21, 2018, the City of Marshall submitted an affidavit attesting to the provision of notice to current customers, neighboring utilities and affected parties. The affidavit did not indicate the date on which the notice was mailed, nor included a copy of the notice and the map showing the requested area. Also, the City provided a list of 1,124 customers to provide notice but neither the affidavit nor the list indicate that notice was issued to all current customers.

The administrative law judge finds the notice deficient and the following revised procedural schedule applies:

Event	Date
Deadline for the City to file with the Commission signed affidavits that notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	February 21, 2019
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of the City filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
