ORDER NO. 5 FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's April 12, 2019 recommendation on the administrative completeness and proposed notice of Pendleton Harbor Water Supply Corporation and G-M Water Supply Corporation's application.

The administrative law judge finds the application administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner and form described in the memorandum of Kathryn Eiland of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, dated April 12, 2019.
