

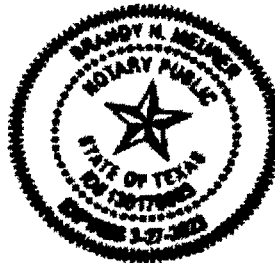

G-M Water Supply Corporation (G-M) has submitted an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to purchase water facilities and cancel Pendleton Harbor Water Supply Corporation Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 10737 and amend G-M's (CCN) No. 11393 in Sabine County.

The sale is scheduled to take place as approved by the Commission (V.T.C.A., Water Code § 13.301). The transaction and the transfer of the CCN includes the following subdivision: Pendleton Harbor Subdivision.

The requested area subject to this transaction is located approximately 9.3 miles north-east of downtown Hemphill, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Toledo Bend Reservoir; on the east by Toledo Bend Reservoir; on the south by State Highway 21 and Toledo Bend Reservoir; and on the west by intersection of Cedar Grove Road and Elma Lane. The total requested area for the water CCN being transferred and amended includes approximately 1,024 acres and 234 current customers.

This transaction will have the following effect on the current customers' rates and services: All of the customers will be charged G-M's current rates.

Persons who wish to intervene in the proceeding or comment upon action sought should contact the Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 13326, Austin, Texas 78711-3326, or call the Public Utility Commission at (512) 936-7120 or (888) 782-8477. Hearing- and speech-impaired individuals with text telephone (TTY) may contact the commission at (512) 936-7136. The deadline for intervention in the proceeding is (30 days from the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later, unless otherwise provided by the presiding officer). You must send a letter requesting intervention to the commission which is received by that date.

A landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the requested area, may file a written request with the Commission to be excluded from the requested area ("opt out") within (30) days from the date that

notice was provided by the Utility. All opt out requests must include a large scale map and a metes and bounds description of the landowner's tract of land.
