
ORDER OF DISMISSAL WITHOUT PREJUDICE

This Order addresses the petition of T.J. Bradshaw Construction, Ltd. requesting expedited release of a 256.33-acre tract from Jonah Special Utility District's water and sewer certificates of convenience and necessity in Williamson County. After the Commission administrative law judge issued a proposal for decision, T.J. Bradshaw Construction filed a request to withdraw its petition based on an agreement between T.J. Bradshaw Construction and Jonah Special Utility District.

At the Commission's November 14, 2019 open meeting, the Commission evaluated T.J. Bradshaw Construction's request to withdraw its petition. The Commission finds that the agreement between T.J. Bradshaw Construction and Jonah Special Utility District renders the petition unnecessary and constitutes good cause for withdrawal under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.181(g)(3). Accordingly, this proceeding is dismissed without prejudice under 16 TAC § 22.181(a).


