On November 20, 2019, the Public Utility Commission (the "Commission") issued a final order dismissing the proceeding without prejudice. *Petition of T.J. Bradshaw Construction, Ltd. to Amend Jonah Special Utility District's Certificates of Convenience and Necessity in Williamson County by Expedited Release*, Docket No. 48801, Order of Dismissal Without Prejudice (Nov. 20, 2019).

Currently, Commission records in the Water and Sewer CCN Viewer database do not reflect the Commission's final order. Rather, records indicate T.J. Bradshaw Construction, Ltd.'s 256.33-acre tract was released from Jonah Special Utility District's certificate of convenience and necessity. See Exhibits A and B. 


