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**ORDER NO. 1
REQUIRING COMMENTS ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND NOTICE;
AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

I. Petition

This Order addresses the petition filed and subsequently corrected on October 18, 2018 and October 23, 2018, respectively by T.J. Bradshaw Construction, Ltd. requesting the expedited release of 256.33 acres of land located within the boundaries of Jonah Special Utility District's water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 10970 and sewer CCN number 21053 in Williamson County.

II. Requiring Comments on the Administrative Completeness

By November 17, 2018, Commission Staff must file comments regarding the administrative completeness of the petition and notice.

The Commission will publish notice of the petition in the *Texas Register*. The Commission will provide a copy of the notice filed with the *Texas Register* to Jonah Special Utility District at its address of record:

In accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.104(b), Jonah Special Utility District must file a motion to intervene by November 17, 2018, in order to participate as a party in this proceeding.

III. Establishing Procedural Schedule

The following procedural schedule applies to this proceeding:

Commission Staff's comments on the administrative completeness of the petition and notice	November 17, 2018
Deadline for Jonah Special Utility District and other affected persons to file a written protest or motion to intervene and file comments on the petition	November 17, 2018

Additional deadlines will be established after the petition is deemed administratively complete.

IV. Filing Requirements

Unless otherwise specified, an original and ten copies of documents relating to this proceeding must be filed with the Commission's filing clerk in accordance with 16 TAC § 22.71. A copy of each document filed with the Commission must also be served on all parties as required by 16 TAC § 22.74. All filings can be accessed on the PUC Interchange webpage at, <http://interchange.puc.texas.gov>.


