SOAH ORDER NO. 11
ADOPTING REVISED INTERIM PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE;
ADDRESSING REQUEST TO INTERVENE

On February 26, 2021, staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice provided by Northtown Acres Water Supply (Applicant). Staff recommends that Applicant's form of notice be found sufficient. However, Staff raised concerns that some customers had not received the notice, and therefore, recommended that Applicant reissue notice with a new effective date and file a new affidavit of notice.

In response, Applicant filed an affidavit attesting that notice was provided on March 1, 2021, and proposed a new effective date of April 5, 2021. Given this action, the Administrative Law Judges (ALJs) set aside the interim procedural schedule set out in SOAH Order No. 10 and adopt the revised interim procedural schedule recommended by Staff, as follows:


Event	Deadline
Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	March 25, 2021
Intervention Deadline	April 5, 2021
Parties to submit a joint proposed procedural schedule or to request a prehearing conference	April 12, 2021

On February 3, 2021, Mark Parker filed a request to intervene in this proceeding. Mr. Parker was previously granted party status and remains a party to this case.¹
