**SOAH ORDER NO. 13**

**FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT; SUSPENDING EFFECTIVE DATE;  
GRANTING MOTIONS TO INTERVENE; ADDRESSING PROCEDURES**

On March 25, 2021, staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) recommended finding the second notice of the revised application provided by Northtown Acres Water Supply (Northtown Acres) sufficient. No objections to the notice were filed. Accordingly, the Administrative Law Judges (ALJs) find notice sufficient.

Staff also requests that the effective date of April 5, 2021, be suspended for a period not to exceed 265 days under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.33(a)(2). The ALJs find that suspension is appropriate. The effective date of Northtown Acres' proposed rates is **SUSPENDED** for 265 days to **December 27, 2021**.

Motions to intervene were filed by Timothy Barnebee, Eric Meyers, Glen Smith, and James Williams.<sup>1</sup> No objections were filed. Therefore, the motions are **GRANTED**.

<sup>1</sup> Glen Smith and James Williams filed the Commission's "ratepayer comments/requests to intervene" form, but it was not clear whether they sought to be commenters or intervenors in this case. By this order, they are granted status as parties, but if that was not their intention, they may file a letter or motion requesting to withdraw as a party.


