**ORDER NO. 4
FINDING APPLICATION REMAINS INCOMPLETE
AND ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the January 17, 2019, application and April 8, 2019, supplemental application filed by Northtown Acres Water Supply.

On May 24, 2019, Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation finding that although the supplemental application cured the initial deficiencies, the filing remains administratively incomplete because Northtown's January 15, 2019, affidavit of proof did not specify that notice was provided to municipalities and to the Office of Public Utility Counsel (OPUC). For this reason, Commission Staff recommends that notice be found insufficient and that Northtown be directed to file a supplemental affidavit specifying the municipalities noticed and an attestation that notice was sent to OPUC.


In light of the above, the administrative law judge finds the application remains administratively incomplete and deficient; is not considered filed with the Commission; and its effective date continues to be suspended until a properly completed application is accepted.

On or before June 10, 2019, Northtown must cure the notice deficiencies described above.

On or before June 17, 2019, Commission Staff is required to file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
