

I recommend making the following changes to the proposed order in this proceeding.

Conclusion of law 10 should be deleted as unnecessary, and the remaining conclusions of law should be renumbered.

Ordering paragraphs 1 and 2 should be amended for clarity and accuracy.

- 1. The Commission grants the petition and <u>amends Aqua's water CCN number 13203 by removing removes</u> the approximately 108-acre tract of land owned by Tejas Creek from Aqua's water CCN number 13203 and sewer CCN number 21065.
- 2. The Commission grants the petition and amends Aqua's sewer CCN number 21065 by removing the approximately 108-acre tract of land owned by Tejas Creek amends Aqua's water CCN number 13203 and sewer CCN number 21065 in accordance with this Order.

Finally, I propose delegating to the Office of Policy and Docket Management staff the authority to modify the order to conform to the *Citation and Style Guide for the Public Utility Commission of Texas* and to make other non-substantive changes to the order for such matters as capitalization, spelling, grammar, punctuation, style, correction of numbering, and readability.

I look forward to discussing this matter with you at the open meeting.
