**ORDER NO. 1  
REQUIRING COMMENTS ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND NOTICE;  
AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

**I. Petition**

This Order addresses the petition filed on October 30, 2018 by Tejas Creek, Ltd. requesting the expedited release of approximately 108 acres of land located within the boundaries of Aqua Texas, Inc.'s water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 13203 and sewer CCN number 21065 in Montgomery County.

**II. Requiring Comments on the Administrative Completeness**

By November 29, 2018, Commission Staff must file comments regarding the administrative completeness of the petition and notice.

In accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.104(b), Aqua Texas, Inc. must file a motion to intervene by November 29, 2018, in order to participate as a party in this proceeding.

### III. Establishing Procedural Schedule

The Commission will establish additional deadlines after the petition is deemed administratively complete.

### IV. Filing Requirements

Unless otherwise specified, an original and ten copies of documents relating to this proceeding must be filed with the Commission's filing clerk in accordance with 16 TAC § 22.71. A copy of each document filed with the Commission must also be served on all parties as required by 16 TAC § 22.74. All filings can be accessed on the PUC Interchange webpage at, <http://interchange.puc.texas.gov>.


