### **NOTICE OF APPROVAL**

This Notice addresses the application of Green Acres Mobile Home Park, LLC for a priceindex rate adjustment. The Commission adjusts Green Acres' water base rate to \$24.84 and gallonage rate to \$1.55 per 1,000 gallons.

The Commission adopts the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

#### I. **Findings of Fact**

#### **Applicant**

- 1. Green Acres Mobile Home Park, LLC is a domestic limited liability company registered with the Texas secretary of state under file number 802797044.
- 2. Green Acres provides water service under certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 11785.
- 3. Green Acres operates Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ)-approved public water system ID No. 0710066 (Green Acres) which serves 47 connections and No. 0170067 (Riverview) which serves 60 connections.

#### **Application**

- 4. On November 1, 2018, Green Acres filed an application for a price-index rate adjustment to its water rates based on the Commission's current price index of 3.50%.
- 5. Green Acres proposed an effective date of February 15, 2019.
- 6. In Order No. 2 issued on December 14, 2018, the administrative law judge (ALJ) found the application administratively complete.

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### **Rate Adjustment**

- 7. Green Acres requested an adjustment to its water-tariff base-rate monthly meter charge and its water gallonage rates based on the Commission's current price index of 3.50%.
- 8. Green Acres proposed increasing the monthly water base rate from \$24.00 to \$24.84 and the gallonage rate from \$1.50 to \$1.55 per 1,000 gallons over the minimum.

## Filing Schedule

- 9. A class C utility with a CCN number ending in 85 may file an application for a price-index rate adjustment in the month of October.
- 10. This filing is the first price index adjustment for Green Acres.

#### Annual Report

11. Green Acres must file its annual service, financial, and normalized-earnings report on June 1 of each year as required by 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.129.

#### **Informal Disposition**

- 12. Green Acres and Commission Staff are the only parties to this proceeding.
- 13. The decision is not adverse to any other party.
- 14. No party has requested a hearing.
- 15. A hearing is not necessary.
- 16. On November 30, 2018, Commission Staff recommended approval of the application.
- 17. Commission Staff attached a proposed tariff to its recommendation filed on November 30, 2018.

#### II. Conclusions of Law

- The Commission has jurisdiction over the application under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.1872.
- Green Acres is a utility as defined in TWC § 13.002(23) and is a class C utility under TWC § 13.002(4-c).

- 3. Under TWC § 13.1872(f), Green Acres may adjust its rates not more than once each year and not more than four times between rate proceedings under TWC § 13.1871.
- 4. An increase in Green Acres rates of 3.5% complies with 16 TAC § 24.49(c)(1).
- 5. The Commission processed the application in accordance with the requirements of the TWC, the Administrative Procedure Act,<sup>1</sup> and Commission's rules.
- Green Acres has demonstrated that it has met the requirements of TWC § 13.1872 and 16 TAC § 24.49 for approval of the rate adjustments.
- 7. The requirements for informal disposition under 16 TAC § 22.35 have been met in this proceeding.
- Under 16 TAC § 24.49(e), Green Acres must provide notice after it receives a copy of this
  Order and 30 days before the effective date of the proposed change.

# **III.** Ordering Paragraphs

In accordance with these findings of fact and conclusions of law, the Commission issues the following orders:

- 1. The Commission adjusts Green Acres' monthly water base rate to \$24.84 and the water gallonage rate to \$1.55 per 1,000 gallons.
- 2. The Commission approves the tariff attached to Commission Staff's recommendation effective 30 days after Green Acres provides notice to its customers.
- Green Acres' new rates may go into effect 30 days after Green Acres provides notice to customers.
- 4. Green Acres must issue notice of the approved rate change to its customers at least 30 days before the effective date of the rate change.
- 5. Within ten days after Green Acres files proof of notice, Commission Staff must file a clean copy of the tariff with Central Records to be marked *Approved* and kept in the Commission tariff book.

6. The Commission denies all other motions and any other requests for general or specific relief, if not expressly granted.
