On September 27, 2016, Ms. Jennifer Brewton of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) Tyler Regional Office conducted an investigation of the above-referenced system to evaluate compliance with applicable requirements for public water supply systems. Enclosed is a summary which lists the investigation findings. During the investigation, certain outstanding alleged violations were identified for which compliance documentation is required, as well as an additional issue which requires your attention.

Please submit compliance documentation, such as a photograph, purchase order, etc., demonstrating what actions were taken by **January 19, 2017**, for the following outstanding alleged violations: **545431, 620703, 620704 and 620705**.



Failure to maintain ground storage tank in strict accordance with AWWA standards.

During the investigation, the investigator observed the 0.013 ground storage tank has sunk into the ground to the point past the bottom of the bolted access door.

Investigation: 1365427

Comment Date: 10/11/2016

See previous comments.

During the investigation, the investigator discussed the needed repairs for the 0.013 MG storage tank. Initially the water system had planned to have the tank raised and a ballast ring installed by September of 2015. However, due to cost and Texas Water System's anticipated completion of the purchase of the water system, system officials indicated the maintenance of the tank would not be feasible until the purchase is finalized.

Recommended Corrective Action: Please submit a compliance plan by November 21, 2016. The plan should include the proposed actions to be taken to correct the alleged violation and a schedule for the completion of the corrections. 


