ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION INSUFFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the application filed on November 19, 2018, of the City of Celina and Marilee Special Utility District (applicants) for approval of a service area contract under Texas Water Code § 13.248 and to amend certificates of convenience and necessity in Collin County. On December 17, 2018, Commission Staff recommended that the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) find the application deficient and provide the applicants an opportunity to cure the deficiencies described in the recommendation. Commission Staff identified various mapping deficiencies in the application. In addition, it appears to the ALJ that the application lacks the requisite notice-related information required by 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.253(b)(4) and (c).

For the foregoing reasons, the ALJ finds the application incomplete and deficient. Under 16 TAC § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.


On or before January 18, 2019, the applicants must supplement the application to cure the identified deficiencies. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed.

On or before February 18, 2019, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
