COME NOW Harper Water Company, Inc. and Aqua Texas, Inc. ("Aqua") (collectively, "Applicants") and file this request for an extension of time to file the customer deposit list as instructed in Order No. 6. In support, Applicants respectfully show the following.

On October 16, 2018, Applicants filed an application for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Gillespie and Kerr Counties, Texas. On August 26, 2019, the Administrative Law Judge denied Applicants' Motion for Good Cause Exception and ordered Applicants to file a customer deposit list which contains customer names and billing addresses.
