COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this recommendation. Staff recommends that notice be deemed sufficient. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On November 20, 2018, Aqua Texas, Inc. filed an application for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission). Aqua Texas stated in its application that it is seeking to acquire facilities and certificate rights from Kerrville South Water Company, Inc., pursuant to § 13.301 of the Texas Water Code and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.239.

On January 2, 2019, the Commission's administrative law judge issued Order No. 2, which required Aqua Texas to file signed affidavits of notice along with copies of notice by January 22, 2019. Order No. 2 further required Staff to submit a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice within ten days after the applicant filed proof of completed notice.

On January 22, 2019, Aqua Texas filed proof of completed notice. Staff's recommendation is therefore timely.

II. RECOMMENDATION ON NOTICE

Aqua Texas filed proof of completed notice in accordance with 16 TAC § 24.239(a)–(c). Staff has reviewed the applicants' proof of notice and found it to be sufficient. Therefore, Staff respectfully recommends that notice be found sufficient.

III. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff recommends the notice be found sufficient. Staff therefore proposes the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for intervention	February 11, 2019 ¹
Deadline for Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation on the approval of the sale and on the CCN amendment	March 13, 2019
Deadline for parties to file a response to Staff's recommendation	March 27, 2019
120-day deadline for the Commission to approve the sale or require a hearing	May 13, 2019 ²

IV. CONCLUSION

For the reasons discussed above, Staff recommends that Aqua Texas's notice be deemed sufficient and respectfully requests that the amended proposed procedural schedule be adopted.

² Pursuant to 16 TAC § 24.239(a) and (j), the deadline for Commission action is 120 days after the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later. One hundred twenty days after January 11, 2019 is May 11, 2019, and the next business day is May 13, 2019.
