

- a. Designation of Information:** Highly Sensitive Protected Material
- b. Description of Document:** Materials submitted to or shared with S&P, Moody's and Fitch regarding the Proposed Transactions and/or any alternatives to the Proposed Transactions
- c. Applicable Exemptions:** Tex. Gov't Code §§ 552.101, 552.104, and 552.110
- d. Explanation of Designation:** The information contained in this exhibit includes Sempra's financial and commercial evaluation of the Proposed Transactions, as well as business strategy and potential credit effects. The Proposed Transactions have not yet closed, and a third party could still submit a competing offer. In addition, the documents provide detailed insight into Sempra's approach to business transactions generally, which, if disclosed publicly, could be used to Sempra's detriment by counterparties in future negotiations and transactions. Accordingly, such information is competitively sensitive and, if publicly disclosed, would cause substantial competitive harm to Sempra or give an advantage to a competitor or bidder.
- e. Certification of Counsel** The undersigned counsel has reviewed the information sufficiently to state in good faith that the information is exempt from discovery under the PIA and is entitled to its classification specified above.

- d. Explanation of Designation:** The information contained in this exhibit includes communications between Sempra and rating agencies regarding the Proposed Transactions. Those communications are not public and include sensitive financial and other commercial information about the Proposed Transactions. The Proposed Transactions have not yet closed, and a third party could still submit a competing offer. In addition, the communications provide detailed insight into Sempra's approach to business transactions generally, which, if disclosed publicly, could be used to Sempra's detriment by counterparties in future negotiations and transactions. Accordingly, such information is competitively sensitive and, if publicly disclosed, would cause substantial competitive harm to Sempra or give an advantage to a competitor or bidder.

Accordingly, such information is competitively sensitive and, if publicly disclosed, would cause substantial competitive harm to Sempra or give an advantage to a competitor or bidder.
