
ORDER REQUESTING LISTS OF ISSUES

Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC, Sharyland Distribution & Transmission Services, L.L.C., Sharyland Utilities, L.P., and Sempra Energy jointly filed a report and application under Public Utility Regulatory Act (PURA) §§ 14.101, 39.262, and 39.915, seeking a determination from the Commission that certain transactions are in the public interest.

The Commission will issue in this docket a preliminary order that will contain a list of the issues to be addressed in this docket, as well as any necessary statement of Commission policy, precedent, or position on any threshold legal or policy issues relevant to this proceeding. To assist the Commission in drafting that order, Oncor, Sharyland Distribution & Transmission Services, Sharyland Utilities, and Sempra Energy shall, and the Commission Staff and any other interested party may, file in this docket a list of issues to be addressed in the docket by **January 4, 2019**. This pleading may also identify any issues that should not be addressed in the docket, and identify any threshold legal and policy issues that should be briefed for purposes of a preliminary order. Specific explanations should support any issues not to be addressed or threshold issues identified in the pleading. Parties shall not file responses to any pleading submitted in response to this Order, unless specifically requested.

The Commission's preliminary order will provide a list of issues and areas that must be addressed in this proceeding and any necessary statement of Commission policy, precedent, or position on threshold issues, or combination thereof, relevant to this proceeding. The Commission will consider and possibly adopt a preliminary order in this docket in the open meeting currently scheduled to convene on **January 17, 2019**.
