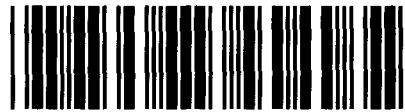

**PROPOSED NOTICE OF APPROVAL**

This Notice of Approval addresses Oncor Electric Delivery Company LLC’s (“Oncor’s” or “Company’s”) petition for administrative approval of an update to its transmission cost recovery factor (“TCRF”) pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code § 25.193 (TAC). The docket was processed in accordance with applicable statutes and Public Utility Commission of Texas (“Commission”) rules. Notice of the application was provided to interested parties and no protests or requests for hearing were filed. Oncor and Commission Staff (“Staff”) are the only parties to the proceeding. Commission Staff recommended approval of the Petition as filed. The Petition is approved effective for billings for scheduled meter readings on or after March 1, 2019, as set forth below.

**Background**

Oncor initiated this docket on November 30, 2018, by filing a petition for administrative approval of its TCRF pursuant to 16 TAC § 25.193(b). Oncor is a transmission and distribution utility providing Delivery Service pursuant to a tariff filed with and approved by the Commission. The tariff contains Section 6.1.1.6.1 - Rider Transmission Cost Recovery Factor (TCRF), which authorizes the Company to charge or credit its customers for the cost of wholesale transmission cost changes approved or allowed by the Commission to the extent that such costs vary from the transmission service cost utilized to set Oncor’s base rates.

As a distribution service provider (DSP), Oncor is authorized through 16 TAC § 25.193(b) to update its TCRF on March 1 and September 1 of each year.

## I. Findings of Fact

### Procedural History

1. On November 30, 2018, Oncor filed its Petition to update its TCRF pursuant to 16 TAC § 25.193(b).
2. On November 30, 2018, the Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) issued Order No. 1, requiring Staff to file comments and/or a recommendation regarding Oncor’s notice and Petition and to provide a proposed procedural schedule for processing.
3. On December 6, 2018, Oncor filed an affidavit attesting that on November 30, 2018, a copy of the Petition was sent to all Retail Electric Providers (REPs) certificated by the Commission.
4. On December 13, 2018, Staff filed its recommendation in response to Order No. 1, recommending that the ALJ find the application and notice sufficient and proposing a procedural schedule.
5. On January 3, 2019, Staff filed its Final Recommendation, recommending that the Commission approve the Petition as filed.
6. On January 10, 2019, Oncor filed a joint request to admit evidence and proposed notice of approval with proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs in response to Order No. 1.
7. On January \_\_, 2019, the ALJ issued Order No. 2 admitting the following into evidence: (1) Oncor’s petition and all attachments, filed November 30, 2018; (2) Oncor’s affidavit attesting to the provision of notice, filed December 6, 2018; and (3) Commission Staff’s Final Recommendation, filed January 3, 2019.

### **Oncor's Request**

9. Oncor seeks approval of the updated TCRF charges shown in column (h) of Attachment A to Oncor's petition.

### **II. Conclusions of Law**

1. Oncor is an electric utility as defined in §§ 11.004 and 31.002(6) of the Public Utility Regulatory Act, TEX. UTIL. CODE ANN. §§ 11.001-66.016 ("PURA").
2. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to §§ 32.001 and 32.101 of PURA.
3. The docket was processed in accordance with PURA and Commission rules.
4. Oncor is authorized to update its TCRF on March 1 and September 1 of each year pursuant to 16 TAC § 25.193(b).
5. The application does not constitute a major rate proceeding as defined by 16 TAC § 22.2.
6. The requirements for informal disposition under 16 TAC § 22.35 have been met in this proceeding.

### **III. Ordering Paragraphs**

In accordance with these findings of fact and conclusions of law, the Commission issues the following Order:

1. The Petition of Oncor, filed on November 30, 2018, is approved and shall be effective for billings for scheduled meter readings on and after March 1, 2019.
2. Within ten days of the date of this Notice of Approval, Oncor shall file a clean copy of the approved Tariff Rate Schedule, 6.1.1.6.1 - Rider TCRF - Transmission Cost Recovery Factor - to be stamped "Approved" by the Commission's Central Records Division.
3. All other motions, requests for entry of specific findings of fact and conclusions of law,

and any other requests for general or specific relief, if not expressly granted herein, are hereby denied.
