ORDER NO. 1 REQUIRING COMMENTS ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

I. Petition

This Order addresses the petition filed on November 30, 2018, by AIRW 2017-7, L.P., requesting the expedited release of 138.413 acres of land located within the boundaries of the City of McKinney's water certificate of convenience and necessity number 20071 in Collin County.

II. Requiring Comments on the Administrative Completeness

By January 2, 2019, Commission Staff must file comments regarding the administrative completeness of the petition and notice.

IV. Filing Requirements

Unless otherwise specified, an original and ten copies of documents relating to this proceeding must be filed with the Commission's filing clerk in accordance with 16 TAC § 22.71. A copy of each document filed with the Commission must also be served on all parties as required by 16 TAC § 22.74. All filings can be accessed on the PUC Interchange webpage at, http://interchange.puc.texas.gov.

All parties will provide their current addresses, telephone and fax numbers, if available, to all other parties and the Commission by filing and serving all parties with such information. Each party must provide the Commission and all parties with updated address, telephone, and fax information, if such information changes. The telephone and fax numbers will be placed on the service list for this proceeding. Parties are responsible for updating their own service lists to reflect changed information and the addition of any other parties.

V. Ex Parte Communications
