SOAH ORDER NO. 4
DISMISSING DOCKET

On January 9, 2020, the Public Utility Commission of Texas staff (Staff) filed a notice of withdrawal, asking that the docket be closed and dismissed without prejudice to refile. Staff explained that Phonoscope Enterprises Group, LLC has corrected the compliance issues that led Staff to file its petition initiating this docket.

A party that initiated a proceeding may withdraw its application without prejudice to refile at any time before that party has presented its direct case.¹ Staff has not yet presented its direct case in this proceeding. An order by an Administrative Law Judge dismissing a proceeding based solely on the withdrawal of an application is the final order of the Commission and such an order does not require the preparation or inclusion of a proposal for decision.²

Accordingly, Staff's requests are **GRANTED**, and this case is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE** from the dockets of the State Office of Administrative Hearings and the Commission pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.181(f)(2) and (6), (g)(1), and (5).
