JOINT STATUS REPORT OF COMMISSION STAFF AND EXTENET SYSTEMS, INC.

In response to the Commission's Order Regarding List of Issues¹ and SOAH Order No. 1 Abating SOAH Proceeding,² Commission Staff and ExteNet Systems, Inc. (ExteNet) file this joint status report, due April 12, 2019.³

This matter was referred to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) on February 5, 2019.⁴ The order of referral directed Commission Staff and ExteNet to file proposed lists of issues to be addressed in this docket by February 12, 2019.⁵ On February 8, 2019, Commission Staff and ExteNet filed a joint motion to abate the filing of the list of issues and the docket⁶ on the grounds that additional time for negotiations could allow the parties to narrow the scope of a hearing, eliminate the need for a hearing, or settle the case without the need for a hearing.⁷

The Commission granted the motion to abate on February 11, 2019 and instructed the parties to file a status report within 60 days of the date the order was signed.⁸ SOAH additionally issued an order on February 21, 2019 granting the motion to abate and adopting the same deadline as the Commission order for the parties to file a status report.⁹ The status report is due on April 12, 2019.


