**ORDER NO. 2  
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND ESTABLISHING  
OPPORTUNITY TO CURE; AND SUSPENDING EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Order addresses the December 14, 2018 application filed by Frio Canyon Water, Inc. to change rates. On January 30, 2019, Commission Staff filed comments on the administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice.

The Commission finds the application incomplete and deficient. The Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before February 14, 2019, Frio Canyon Water must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the January 30, 2019 memorandum from Nabaraj Pokharel and Andrew Novak. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. Frio Canyon Water may not issue notice until the application is administratively complete.


On or before February 28, 2019, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.

Under Texas Water Code § 13.1871(e) and Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(b), the effective date of the proposed rate change is suspended until a properly completed application is accepted.
