ORDER NO. 1 REQUIRING COMMENTS ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

I. Petition

This Order addresses the petition of AIRW 2017-7, L.P., filed on December 17, 2018, requesting the streamlined expedited release of approximately 138 acres of land located within the boundaries of City of McKinney's sewer certificate of convenience and necessity number 20071 in Collin County.

II. Requiring Comments on the Administrative Completeness

All parties will provide their current addresses, telephone and fax numbers, if available, to all other parties and the Commission by filing and serving all parties with such information. Each party must provide the Commission and all parties with updated address, telephone, and fax information, if such information changes. The telephone and fax numbers will be placed on the service list for this proceeding. Parties are responsible for updating their own service lists to reflect changed information and the addition of any other parties.

V. Ex Parte Communications

Ex parte communications with the administrative law judge (ALJ) are prohibited under 16 TAC § 22.3(b)(2). Parties should communicate with the ALJ only through written documents filed with the Commission's filing clerk and served on all parties.
