## ORDER NO. 1 SETTTING DEADLINES

This Order address the petition of the Cities of Garland, Mesquite, Plano and Richardson filed under Texas Water Code §§ 12.013(a) and 13.043(f) appealing wholesale water rates charged by North Texas Municipal Water District. Petitioner requests that the Commission find the rates adversely affect the public interest.

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.307(a), the Commission is required to determine, within 30 days of filing, whether the appeal contains all of the information required by the subchapter. For purposes of 16 TAC § 24.307 only, the rule states that the initial review of probable grounds shall be limited to determining whether the appeal meets the requirements of 16 TAC § 24.305.

On or before January 25, 2019, Commission Staff shall file a recommendation on whether the appeal meets the requirements of 16 TAC  $\S$  24.305.

In accordance with 16 TAC § 22.104(b), the deadline to intervene in this proceeding is February 3, 2019.
