**RAYBURN'S NOTICE OF
APPLICATION FOR FIRST UPDATE TO WTS CREDIT RIDER**

Pursuant to the final order of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) in Docket No. 48400,¹ Rayburn Country Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Rayburn) provides this notice to the Commission and interested parties that on June 2, 2021, Rayburn filed an application for approval to update its wholesale transmission service credit rider to implement the hold harmless payment associated with Rayburn's integration of load and associated facilities into the Electric Reliability Council of Texas (ERCOT) region. Ordering Paragraph No. 9 in the final order in Docket No. 48400 states:

Rayburn must pay a total of \$4.5 million each year for five years to ERCOT wholesale transmission customers as agreed to by the signatories and described in finding of fact 58. Rayburn must submit an initial application to establish the wholesale transmission credit rider no later than four months before the integration date. Rayburn must apply annually, or more frequently as needed, to update its wholesale transmission credit rider rate to incorporate any changes to the ERCOT 4CP billing units.

This is Rayburn's first update to its wholesale transmission service credit rider, which is made after final approval of the 2021 transmission service charge matrix in Docket No. 51612.² Rayburn's Application for First Update to Wholesale Transmission Service Credit Rider has been assigned Docket No. 52204.
