ORDER NO. 7 FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On July 23, 2019, Commission Staff filed, in the present docket, a motion to dismiss for failure to prosecute and failure to amend an application because the petitioner, Malone Addition Water System, had not yet filed supplemental information needed to process the petition. On September 27, 2019, AWR Services, on behalf of Malone Addition, filed the requested supplemental information. In its filing on November 26, 2019, Commission Staff considers the supplemental information adequate, recommends the application be deemed administratively complete, and no longer finds dismissal appropriate. The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds Commission Staff's filing on November 26, 2019 to operate as a withdrawal of its motion to dismiss, and the ALJ will not further consider that motion.

Furthermore, the ALJ finds the application administratively complete and directs Malone Addition to provide notice of the application as described in the memorandum of Roshan Pokhrel, attached to Commission Staff's filing on November 26, 2019, using the included forms.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:
