**ORDER NO. 9
FINDING NOTICE DEFICIENT; AND
ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Malone Addition Water System's petition to discontinue water service and cancel its certificate of convenience and necessity in Travis County and the sufficiency of notice. Malone has not provided proof of notice as required in Order No. 8, filed on January 22, 2020.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the notice to be deficient. Malone must provide proof of notice of the petition as described in Commission Staff's sufficiency recommendation.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Malone to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties	March 31, 2020
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a supplemental recommendation on sufficiency of notice	April 15, 2020
Deadline to intervene	April 30, 2020
