PETITION OF MALONE ADDITION WATER SYSTEM TO DISCONTINUE WATER SERVICE AND CANCEL ITS CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY IN TRAVIS COUNTY PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION

ORDER NO. 10 FINDING NOTICE DEFICIENT; AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses Malone Addition Water System's petition to discontinue water service and cancel its certificate of convenience and necessity in Travis County and the sufficiency of notice. Malone has not provided proof of notice as required in Order No. 9, filed on March 9, 2020.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the notice to be deficient. Malone must provide proof of notice of the petition as described in Commission Staff's sufficiency recommendation.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:
