COMMISSION STAFF'S FIRST REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this First Request for Extension of Time. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

On January 10, 2019, Nerro Supply LLC (Nerro), Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 12252, filed an application to implement a pass-through rate change pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.25 for an increase in purchased water fees from the Brazos Valley Groundwater Conservation District (Brazos Valley GCD) effective January 1, 2019. The review of a proposed revision of a utility's billings to its customers to allow the recovery of additional costs under the utility's approved pass through provision is an informal proceeding. On February 5, 2019, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued a notice setting the deadline for Staff's supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of the application and notice by April 4, 2019. This pleading is therefore timely filed.

Staff requires additional time in order to examine issues raised in the pleadings in this docket and respectfully requests an extension of time until April 19, 2019 to file its supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of the application and notice in this matter.
