ORDER NO. 3 FINDING THE NOTICE INSUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the January 15, 2019, application of SWWC Utilities, Inc. dba Southwest Utility Company and Monarch Utilities I L.P. (applicants) for approval of a sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Harris County. The applicants filed an affidavit of notice on February 26, 2019. On March 18, 2019, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of the proposed notice of the application.

The administrative law judge finds the notice insufficient and directs the applicants to refile proof of notice, in the manner and form described in Leila Guerrero's memorandum dated February 13, 2019, including a list of the 44 customers to whom the notice was sent. The following procedural schedule applies:

Deadline for applicants to file signed affidavits that notice was provided, along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties	April 18, 2019
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of applicants filing proof of completed notice
Deadline for affected persons to file motions to intervene; deadline to request a hearing on the merits	30 days after notice is issued
