## ORDER NO. 6 SOLICITING JOINT MOTION TO ADMIT EVIDENCE AND PROPOSED ORDER

This Order addresses the January 15, 2019, application of SWWC Utilities, Inc. dba Southwest Utility Company (SWWC) and Monarch Utilities I L.P. (Monarch) (applicants) for approval of a sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Harris County.

## Evidence Needed to Approve Sale and Allow Transaction to Proceed

The administrative law judge requires an evidentiary record in order to approve the sale and allow the transaction to proceed. The parties are asked to submit a joint motion to admit evidence. The requested motion should include, but is not limited to, a request for admission of:

- 1. The applicants' application;
- 2. The applicants' proof of notice and supporting documentation;
- 3. The applicants' responses to requests for information; and
- 4. Commission Staff's recommendation on the sale.

## Proposed Order Approving Sale and Allowing Transaction to Proceed

Further, the parties are asked to submit a proposed order approving sale and allowing transaction to proceed. The requested proposed order should be modeled, with a comparable level of detail, on Order No. 8 from Docket No. 47592.

The requested joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order must be filed no later than July 15, 2019.
