FINDING CLOSING DOCUMENTATION DEFICIENT AND RESTYLING DOCKET

I. Finding Closing Documentation Deficient

This Order addresses the application of SWWC Utilities, Inc. dba Southwest Utility Company and Monarch Utilities I L.P. (applicants) for approval of a sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Harris County and the deficiencies of the closing documentation. On December 18, 2019 the applicants filed closing documents. Commission Staff filed a recommendation on sufficiency of closing documents on January 2, 2020.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the closing documentation deficient and requires the applicants to submit outstanding customer deposit information as described in Commission Staff's recommendation.

On or before January 16, 2020, the applicants must cure the deficiencies and submit additional closing documentation. Commission Staff must file its recommendation on the closing documentation on or before January 30, 2020, and propose a procedural schedule for further processing of the application.

II. Restyling Docket

Commission Staff requested that the docket be restyled to reflect the correct name of the transferor associated with certificate of convenience and necessity number 12284, SWWC Utilities, Inc. dba SW Utility Company. The ALJ restyles the petition to reflect the correct name. The style is corrected as reflected in this Order.
