## SOAH ORDER NO. 11 MEMORIALIZING THIRD PREHEARING CONFERENCE; REVISING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND RECORD CLOSE DATE; CONTINUING HEARING ON THE MERITS

At its November 14, 2019 open meeting, the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) voted to grant the appeal by the Districts<sup>1</sup> and Commission staff (Staff) of State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) Order No. 7. SOAH Order No. 7 had denied certain discovery relating to prudence issues involving Water Treatment Plant No. 4 (WTP 4).

On November 19, 2019, the Administrative Law Judges (ALJs) convened the third prehearing conference in this case. Austin Water<sup>2</sup> clarified that it is not seeking interim rates at this time. Austin Water, the Districts, and Staff agreed on revisions to the procedural schedule as a result of the Commission's ruling on the appeal. The agreed revisions are ADOPTED, as set forth below.

North Austin Municipal Utility District No. 1, Northtown Municipal Utility District, Travis County Water Control & Improvement District No. 10, and Wells Branch Municipal Utility District (collectively, Districts).

The parties also agreed to the following:

- The Commission's ruling on appeal notwithstanding, at this time, Austin Water is relieved of its obligation to respond to the discovery requests that were the subject of SOAH Order No. 7. The parties may seek such discovery at a later time in accordance with the procedural schedule.
- The deadline for Austin Water's rebuttal testimony to the Districts' direct testimony regarding WTP 4 that has already been filed is June 9, 2020.
- The discovery and testimony referred to above as "WTP 4" is limited to issues involving WTP 4 and prudence/ratemaking standards arising from the Commission's related ruling on the appeal of SOAH Order No. 7.
- For first set of written discovery on Austin Water's direct testimony on WTP 4, responses are due within 20 days of receipt.
- For written discovery on Austin Water's direct testimony on WTP 4 that is: (1) issued after the responses to the first set of written discovery are received, and (2) related to information provided in response to the first such set of written discovery, responses are due within 10 days of receipt.
- For written discovery on Districts' and Staff's direct testimony on WTP 4, responses are due within 5 days of receipt.

The hearing on the merits previously set for December 4, 2019, is **CONTINUED** until 10:00 a.m. on June 23, 2020, at SOAH, William P. Clements State Office Building, 300 West 15th Street, Fourth Floor, Austin, Texas. The hearing will conclude by no later than June 25, 2020.

The ALJs will address pending motions to strike and to compel in a future order.
