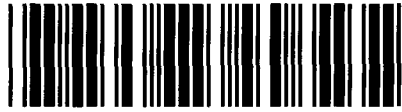

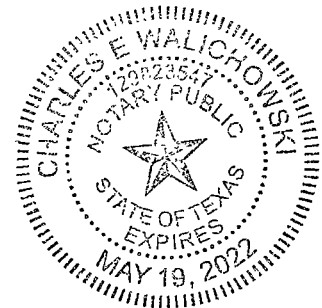

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONROE, TEXAS, ALTERING THE PERMANENT SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED FOR VEHICLES UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE TEXAS TRANSPORTATION CODE, UPON THE BASIS OF AN ENGINEERING AND TRAFFIC INVESTIGATION, UPON CERTAIN STREETS AND HIGHWAYS OF PARTS THEREOF, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CONROE, AS SET OUT IN THIS ORDINANCE, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY OF A FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$200 FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

ALONG FM 1486 FROM WEST CITY LIMIT OF CITY OF CONROE TO WEST CITY LIMIT OF CITY OF CONROE, A DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY 1.138 MILES (FROM REAS TO OLD CONROE ROAD), THE SPEED LIMIT SHALL BE 20 MPH.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO OBTAIN A CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY TO PROVIDE SEWER UTILITY SERVICE IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, TEXAS

Valley Ranch Municipal Utility District No. 1 has filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas to obtain a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) to provide retail sewer utility service, and to decertify a portion of Porter MUD's CCN No. 20573 in Montgomery County.

The requested area is located approximately 1 mile northwest of downtown Porter, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Texas 99; on the east by US 59; on the south by FM 214; and on the west by White Oak Drive and Valley Ranch Parkway. The total requested area includes approximately 830 acres 943 current customers.

The requested area overlaps the boundaries of the Porter MUD. If Porter MUD does not request a public hearing, the Commission shall determine that the district is consenting to Valley Ranch MUD's request to provide retail sewer utility service in the requested area.

Persons who wish to intervene in the proceeding or comment upon action sought should contact the Public Utility Commission of Texas, P.O. The Commission will accept comments from speech-impaired individuals with text telephone (TTY) use. Comments should be filed with the Commission at (512) 936-7135. The deadline for filing comments in the proceeding is thirty (30) days from the mailing of the notice of public hearing, whichever occurs later, unless otherwise provided by the presiding officer. You must send a letter requesting intervention to the Commission which is received by the Commission.

If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is requested, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for its decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding that takes place in state district court.

A landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, wholly or partially located within the requested area, may file a written request with the Commission to be excluded from the requested area (opt out) within 30 days from the date that notice was provided by the Utility. All opt out requests must include a legal description of the tract and a metes and bounds description of the landowner's tract of land.

Persons who wish to request this option should file their request documents with the Commission.
