ORDER NO. 11 GRANTING EXTENSION, REVISING DEADLINE, AND REGARDING ELECTRONIC SERVICE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's March 19, 2020, request to extend the time to file evidence and a proposed order approving the sale and allowing the transaction to proceed. Commission Staff states that further review of the transaction is needed.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) grants Commission Staff's request for extension. By April 9, 2020, the parties must submit a joint motion to admit evidence, including, but not limited to, a request for admission of:

- 1. The applicants' application;
- 2. The applicants' proof of notice and supporting documentation;
- 3. The applicants' responses to requests for information, if any; and
- 4. Commission Staff's recommendation on the sale.

Additionally, by April 9, 2020, the parties are asked to submit a proposed order approving the sale and allowing the transaction to proceed. The requested proposed order should be modeled, with a comparable level of detail, on Order No. 7 from Docket No. 49299.

Within the same filing, Commission Staff filed a motion to require service by electronic mail and to direct any party that has not previously provided an email address to file a notice informing the parties of the email address to be used for service. In light of the Commission's Order entered in Docket No. 50664,¹ Commission Staff's request to require electronic service is

moot. The ALJ, however, orders any party who has not previously provided an email address for service of documents to file in this docket, by no later than March 27, 2020, a notice specifying an email address for service of documents.
