ORDER NO. 10 REQUIRING CLARIFICATION

This Order addresses the need for clarification concerning the joint motion to admit evidence and proposed notice of approval filed on January 23, 2020.

In proposed finding of fact eight, the requested area is stated to comprise approximately 458 acres. However, in the parties' application filed on February 15, 2019, and supplemented on March 4, 2019, and April 9, 2019, the requested area appears to comprise approximately 414 acres.

In the applicants' supplemental information to the application filed on April 9, 2019, the applicants clarified that they did not seek to transfer all of the certified area under water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 12810. Specifically, the applicants stated that approximately 420 acres are not intended to be included in the proposed transaction. However, in proposed findings of fact 23 and 24 in the joint proposed notice of approval, the applicants indicate that all of the facilities and service area under Ponder Enterprises, Inc.'s water CCN number 12810 is to be transferred and water CCN number 12810 is cancelled.

In proposed finding of fact eight, the parties list the Longhorn Meadows, Westover Ranch, Double Rock, and Meadow Ranch subdivisions as part of the requested area. However, the tariff attached to the joint motion to admit evidence and proposed notice of approval does not list the Westover Ranch subdivision

By April 10, 2020, the parties must file in the present docket clarification regarding these discrepancies and file a revised tariff, if appropriate.
