ORDER NO. 2
ADDRESSING SUFFICIENCY OF APPLICATION AND NOTICE;
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the application of Wind Energy Transmission Texas, LLC (WETT) to amend its certificate of convenience and necessity to construct a 138-kilovolt (kV) single circuit transmission line in Borden County.

On March 7, 2019, WETT filed the affidavit of Derrick Berg, Senior Environmental Planner and Project Manager, attesting that notice was provided by mail to neighboring utilities, counties, and the Department of Defense Siting Clearinghouse on February 26, 2019, and to Texas Parks and Wildlife Department on February 27, 2019. Additionally, WETT filed the affidavit of Kerri Dean, editor of the *Borden Star*, attesting to the publication of newspaper notice in the *Borden Star* on February 27, 2019.


The administrative law judge deems the application materially complete and sufficient for further review and approves the provision of notice. The administrative law judge adopts the following procedural schedule:
