**ORDER NO. 7
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE
AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the application filed on February 25, 2019, by Texas Water Systems, Inc. and Undine Texas, LLC for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Gregg, Henderson, Limestone, Smith, and Upshur Counties.

Commission Staff recommends the application be found administratively incomplete for further review. Upon consideration of Commission Staff’s recommendation, the application is found to be administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.8(b).

Under 16 TAC § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it finds the application administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before September 23, 2019, Texas Water Systems and Undine Texas must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in Debbie Reyes’ August 20, 2019, memorandum. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. Texas Water Systems and Undine Texas must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

On or before October 23, 2019, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
