**ORDER NO. 12
REQUESTING CLARIFICATION AND RESTYLING DOCKET**

This Order addresses the need for clarification concerning the application of Texas Water Systems, Inc. and Undine Texas, LLC for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Gregg, Henderson, Smith, Upshur, and Van Zandt counties, to amend their water certificates of convenience and necessity, and for dual certification with Crystal Systems Texas, Inc. and Pritchett Water Supply Corporation.

In Undine’s response to Order No. 9, Undine provided notice of the requested areas subject to the proposed transaction, which included an area identified as Camp Joy, Harmony, and Rosewood. Based on finding of fact number seven of the joint proposed order approving sale and transfer to proceed, filed on May 15, 2020, the requested area identified as Camp Joy appears to be served by the Brookshires Camp Joy water system, and the requested areas Harmony and Rosewood appear to be served by the Rosewood water system. However, Commission Staff’s April 20, 2020 recommendation does not address the Brookshires Camp Joy water system.

On or before July 1, 2020, Commission Staff must clarify whether service currently provided from the Brookshires Camp Joy and Rosewood water systems is adequate and provide their corresponding Texas Commission on Environmental Quality identifying information. Commission Staff must also clarify whether service is being provided to the Harmony area from the Rosewood water system.

On April 20, 2020, Commission Staff requested that the docket be restyled to properly reflect all aspects of the proposed transaction. The administrative grants this request. The style is amended as reflected in this Order.
